The Ohio State University Spring Career Day 2009!

WHEN:

April 7th, 10:00 am to 3:00 pm & April 8th, 8:00 am to 4:30 pm

WHERE:

Both the Career Fair (Day One) & Interview Day (Day Two) will be held in the Huntington Club (Ohio Stadium)

HOW:

The registration fee is \$145 for nonprofit organizations and government agencies and \$445 for corporate employers. The registration fee does not include Interview Day. The fee for Interview Day is \$75 for nonprofit organizations and government agencies and \$100 for corporate employers.

For an additional \$200, you may choose to reserve a suite over-looking the football field. You'll experience the luxury of a quiet space for speaking with and possibly interviewing students away from the crowd. Only a limited amount of suites are available.
